Cost: €1445 per person sharing

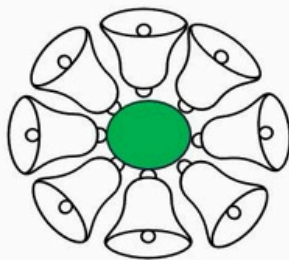
